

# Transportation Services for Derby Residents

## The Derby Dash

The Derby Dash provides on-demand, curb-to-curb transportation for people who live in the Derby city limits. Reservations are based on availability. Cost for a one-way ride is \$2. Derby Dash staff will attempt to accommodate wheelchairs based on size and total weight of the wheelchair. People who recycle and earn "Recycling points" through the City's franchise agreement with Waste Connections may be eligible for a Derby Dash coupon at [www.RecycleBank.com](http://www.RecycleBank.com). Individuals may be eligible for subsidized rides through an application process. Call 788-7433 for information. This service is provided by the City of Derby.

## Sedgwick County Transportation (SCT)

Sedgwick County Transportation operates subsidized, door-to-door transportation for seniors throughout Sedgwick County – except, if you live in Wichita. SCT is NOT accepting applications at this time for people who live in Wichita. If you live in Wichita, call the number below for a referral to other available resources.

If you live in other areas within Sedgwick County, except Wichita, you can call the number below for an application by mail or click [here](#). Completed applications must be mailed to Sedgwick County Transportation. Allow up to one week (five working days) for the application to be processed. For Derby residents (and others outside Wichita), rides are ONLY provided for medical appointments.

In addition to completing the Sedgwick County Transportation Application, if you answer "yes" to either of the following questions, also print and complete the [Caregiver Supplement Application](#) or call for a copy by mail.

1. Are you a caregiver to a person over age 60 and reside in Butler, Harvey or Sedgwick County and need to arrange transportation for the person you provide care to in order to relieve yourself?
2. Are you a caregiver for a person over age 60 and reside in Sedgwick County and need to arrange transportation for yourself to visit the person you care for in the hospital, assisted living facility or nursing home in Wichita?

## Taxi Service

Fares for services are \$2 flag fee, plus \$2 per mile. The cost to wait somewhere is .40 per minute. These companies are wheelchair accessible to those with manual, fold-up wheelchairs and who can transfer themselves from the wheelchair to the vehicle seat. Call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to schedule a ride.

## Medicaid Transportation

People on Medicaid are required to contact their managed care organization (MCO) to arrange non-emergency medical transportation. The toll-free phone number for transportation providers is printed on the Medicaid member's identification card. Schedule a ride 24-hours-a-day.

## Cancer Patient Transportation

The American Cancer Society provides rides for people who have a cancer diagnosis and are traveling to a cancer-related medical appointment. Volunteers drive their own cars at their own expense. Clients must be able to walk unassisted to and from the vehicle or have an accompanying caregiver to assist. Schedule a ride 24-hours-a-day, 7-days-a-week by calling their toll-free number below.

## Public Transit in Wichita

Wichita Transit operates a bus system to the general public from 6 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Saturdays. Service area includes the city limits of Wichita only with designated boundaries. One-way fare is \$1.75, or .85 cents for the Half-Fare program. Half-Fare is available for persons with disabilities and persons age 65 and older with an approved Half-Fare identification card. Please call to find out how to obtain the required photo identification card and for information on bus routes.
