# TRASH & RECYCLING INFORMATION

*for Derby Residents*

Waste Connections is the exclusive provider of trash and recycling services for Derby residents. Here are the trash and recycle curbside service options:

1. **\$37.96 per quarter:** A 35-gallon trash cart serviced once a week and a 95-gallon recycle cart serviced every other week. \$1 fee for each extra trash bag by cart.
2. **\$45.02 per quarter:** A 65-gallon trash cart serviced once a week and a 95-gallon recycle cart serviced every other week. \$1 fee for each extra trash bag by cart.
3. **\$52.10 per quarter:** A 95-gallon trash cart trash serviced once a week and a 95-gallon recycle cart serviced every other week. Includes up to 10 additional trash bags per week. Over 10, \$1 per bag charge.



Derby residents who are Waste Connections customers may either have two bulk items picked up at the curbside for free OR have one curbside item and one transfer station trip free of charge. Please call WCI to set schedule.

## How to Place Your Carts

Place trash carts within two feet of the curb (unless you have made other arrangements with Waste Connections). Do not place carts near cars, mailboxes, trees or anything that might get in the way of service.

Place your recycle cart within three feet of the curb and two feet away from your trash cart so the driver has easy access to both carts.

Set out both carts by 6 a.m. on your service day and return to your storage area by 9 a.m. the day after your service.

Waste Connections provides free cart roll-out service for senior citizens and citizens with disabilities. Driver's license or disability card is required for this service.



# GET REWARDED FOR RECYCLING



In addition to trash service, Waste Connections offers single-stream recycling for Derby residents. Waste Connections and Recycling Perks have partnered to provide a sustainable and effective recycling program that benefits Derby residents, businesses and the environment. All your approved recyclable items go into one, 95-gallon cart - there is no need to divide recyclables into separate containers or bags. This system makes recycling easy.

## Recycle the following items. Please rinse out all food and beverage containers.

Aluminum cans	Magazines/catalogs/junk mail
Aluminum foil, clean	Newspapers & inserts
Food boxes - cereal, soda, etc.	Office paper & file folders
Corrugated cardboard (flatten all boxes)	Phone books, soft and hard back books
Glass jars & bottles	Plastics #1-7
Paper bags	Tin, steel and aerosol cans

### How it Works

Every other week, Waste Connections will weigh household recyclables at the curb. Each recycle cart has an ID tag that is recorded by the recycling truck and converted into Recycling Perks Points. You will receive 50 points every time you recycle. Registered participants can earn up to \$25 in discounts a month and \$300 in discounts each year. Participants may redeem their earned rewards for coupons, discounts and special deals with local vendors, retailers, restaurants, grocers and more.
