

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE POPULATION OF THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS AS GREATER THAN FIFTEEN THOUSAND (15,000) FOR PURPOSES OF TRANSITION TO A CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS IN ACCORDANCE WITH K.S.A. 13-101.

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 13-101, whenever it is duly ascertained by any census of enumeration taken under any law of the United States or of the state of Kansas or by a city that such city has attained a population of greater than fifteen thousand, such fact shall be certified to the governor of the state, who shall issue a public proclamation declaring such city to be a city of the first class; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with K.S.A. 13-101, the City of Derby adopted Resolution No. 23-2007 whereby it, having a population of at least fifteen thousand but less than twenty-five thousand, elected to continue to operate as a city of the second class having determined that it would be more advantageous for Derby to continue to operate as a city of the second class; and

WHEREAS, Derby's estimated population as of July 1, 2019 is 24,943; and

WHEREAS, a city is required to become a "City of the First Class" upon reaching a population of 25,000; and

WHEREAS, Derby has been preparing to become a city of the first class and, in accordance with the requirements of K.S.A. 13-101, has asked Governor Laura Kelly to issue a public proclamation declaring Derby to be a City of the First Class as of November 11, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DERBY:

Section 1. Certification of Population. The governing body of the City of Derby, Kansas hereby certifies that the City of Derby has attained a population greater than fifteen thousand making it eligible to become a city of the first class.


Section 2. Finding of Advisability to Become a City of the First Class. The City of Derby, Kansas, having previously elected via Derby Resolution No. 23-2007 to continue to operate as a city of the second class, hereby finds that it is now advantageous to the City of Derby to become a city of the first class and requests that Governor Laura Kelly issue a public proclamation proclaiming Derby to be a city of the first class in the State of Kansas effective November 11, 2020.

Section 3. Effective date. This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action by the City Council.


