

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS DESIGNATING THE OFFICIAL CITY NEWSPAPER.

WHEREAS, the City of Derby, Kansas, a city of the first class, is required by state statute to designate by resolution a newspaper to be the official city newspaper; and

WHEREAS, state law requires that the official city newspaper of a city of the first class meet the following publication requirements:

1. Published at least weekly 50 times a year and has been so published for at least one year prior to the publication of any official city publication;
2. is entered at the post office as periodical class mail matter;
3. has general paid circulation on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis in the county in which the city located and is not a trade, religious or fraternal publication; and
4. is published in the county in which the city publishing the official publication is located; and

WHEREAS, prior to its November 11, 2020, designation as a city of the first class, official City publications were made in *The Derby Informer*; and

WHEREAS, *The Derby Informer* meets all of the requirements necessary to be designated the official city newspaper for a city of the first class.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DERBY:

Section 1. Designation of Official City Newspaper. The City of Derby, Kansas, a city of the first class, does hereby designate *The Derby Informer* as the official city newspaper pursuant to K.S.A. 64-101.

Section 2. Effective date. This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption.
