

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 10

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS, FROM CERTAIN PORTIONS OF K.S.A. 12-1503, AND AMENDING CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS PLUMBING CODE TO EXEMPT THE BOARD OF EXAMINATORS AND GAS FITTERS, AND TO ALLOW THE APPOINTMENT OF TWO MEMBERS OF SAID BOARD OUTSIDE OF THE CITY OF DERBY, AND TO CREATE THE POSITION OF A HEALTH OFFICER FOR THE CITY OF DERBY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DERBY,
KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Derby, Kansas, a Mayor-Council City of the Second Class, by the power vested in it pursuant to Article 10, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to and does hereby exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it certain portions of K.S.A. 12-1503, and further amends Section 21.08.010 of the City of Derby, Kansas Plumbing Code to expand the Board of Examiners and Gas Fitters, and to allow the appointment of two members of said board outside of the City of Derby, and to authorize the appointment of a Health Officer for the City of Derby.

Section 2. The mayor, with the consent of the council, shall appoint a Board of Examiners of Plumbers and Gas Fitters consisting of five members.

Section 3. One member of said board shall be the Derby Health Officer, or a medical doctor.

Section 4. The second and third members of said Board shall be master plumbers, the fourth shall be a journeyman plumber, and the fifth a master gas fitter.

Section 5. The first, second and third members hereinabove described shall be appointed for one year terms. The fourth and fifth members of the Board shall be appointed for two year terms. Each year after their initial term each Board member shall be appointed for two years commencing May 1, or until their successors shall have been appointed. Vacancies on such Board of Examiners of Plumbers and Gas Fitters shall be filled by the Mayor with the consent of the Governing Body.

Section 6. A health officer shall be appointed each year by the mayor with the consent of the council, and shall be a medical doctor, an osteopath, or someone specially educated by training or experience in the public health field.


Section 7. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 8. This is a Charter Ordinance, and shall take effect sixty-one days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for referendum is filed and referendum held on the Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, subdivision (c) (3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 6th day of April, 1976.
