

ORDINANCE NO. 12

A CHARTER ORDINANCE REPEALING CITY OF DERBY CHARTER
ORDINANCE NO. 3, WHICH ORDINANCE PROVIDES FOR THE
SALARY OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DERBY,
KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Derby, Kansas by the power vested in it
under Article XII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, and
amendments thereto, hereby elects to make inapplicable to it and to exempt
itself from the provisions of Charter Ordinance No. 3, which ordinance
provides for salaries for the Mayor and Councilmen.

SECTION 2. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect
sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for
a referendum is filed, and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in
Article XII, Section 5, Subdivision (c) (3), of the Constitution of Kansas,
in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority
of the electors voting thereon. Said Charter Ordinance No. 3 is hereby repealed.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the
members elect voting in favor thereof, this 6th day of April,
1976.
