

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 14

A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 10 OF THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS, WHEREBY THE BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF PLUMBERS AND GAS FITTERS IS EXPANDED TO SIX MEMBERS INCLUDING ONE JOURNEYMAN GAS FITTER AND REPEALING SECTIONS 2, 4, AND 5 OF CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 10.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF DERBY:

SECTION 1. Sections 2, 4, and 5 of Charter Ordinance No. 10 of the City of Derby are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Charter Ordinance No. 10 shall be amended to read as follows:

The Mayor, with the consent of the council, shall appoint a Board of Examiners of Plumbers and Gas Fitters consisting of six members.

SECTION 3. Section 4 of Charter Ordinance No. 10 shall be amended to read as follows:

The second and third members of said Board shall be master plumbers, the fourth shall be a journeyman plumber, the fifth a master gas fitter, and the sixth, a journeyman gas fitter.

SECTION 4. Section 5 of Charter Ordinance No. 10 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The first, second and third members hereinabove described shall be appointed for one year terms. The fourth, fifth and sixth members of the Board shall be appointed for two year terms. Each year after their initial term each Board member shall be appointed for three years commencing on May 1, or until their successors shall have been appointed. Vacancies on such Board of Examiners of Plumbers and Gas Fitters shall be filled by the Mayor with the consent of the Governing Body.

SECTION 5. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper.

SECTION 6. This is a Charter Ordinance, and shall take effect sixty-one days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for referendum is filed and referendum held on the Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, subdivision (c) (3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 19th day of April, 1977.
