

A CHARTER ORDINANCE REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE 13; CREATING A PARK BOARD , ESTABLISHING AND REDUCING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS, WHO SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION, AND THE TERMS OF OFFICE: AND EXEMPTING THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS FROM CERTAIN PORTIONS OF K.S.A. 14-537, INsofar AS SAID STATUTE DESIGNATES THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS WHO SHALL SERVE AND THE TERMS OF SAID OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS:

Section 1. Charter Ordinance No. 13 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. The City of Derby, Kansas, a Mayor-Council City of the second class, by the power vested in it pursuant to Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, as amended, does hereby exempt itself from and makes inapplicable to it, certain portions of K.S.A. 14-537, and hereby provides substitute and additional provisions, as hereinafter set forth, to-wit:

"Upon the effective date of this ordinance, the Park Board shall be reduced and shall consist of six members, one of whom shall be the Chairman. This reduction shall be accomplished by elimination of the three presently unfilled vacancies."

"On May 1st, 1982, when three additional vacancies are created by reason of expiration of the terms of office of said members, only two of said vacancies shall be filled and the Park Board shall be reduced and shall thereafter consist of five members, one of whom shall be the Chairman. The two members so appointed on May 1st, 1982 shall be appointed for a term of three years. Thereafter, all members shall be appointed to serve two year terms. If by reason of resignation or other vacancy, the number of members shall be reduced to five prior to the effective date of this ordinance, this section shall take effect simultaneously upon the occurrence of said resignation or vacancy.

"The Mayor, by and with the consent of the council, shall appoint the members to the City Park Board, and said members shall serve without compensation. The members shall be resident taxpayers of the City. The Park Board shall elect one of its members to serve as chairman. The City shall provide a secretary, whose function shall be to take the minutes of the meetings."

"The City Park Board shall make an annual report of its proceedings and the condition of the parks of the City to the governing body in the month of February of each year."

Section 3. The City Park Board shall meet at least twice each month and shall make any and all recommendations which it might have to the governing body in writing at least five days prior to the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting.

Section 4. All provisions of any ordinances of the City of Derby, Kansas in conflict herewith are specifically hereby repealed.

Section 5. This charter ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 6. This is a charter ordinance, and shall take effect sixty-one days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance, as provided in Article 12, Section 5, subdivision c(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the governing body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 1st day of December, 1981.
