

A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING  
SECTION 2 OF CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 5  
RELATING TO THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR  
CERTAIN PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Charter Ordinance No. 5 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The governing body is hereby authorized to levy taxes in each year for the general fund and other City purposes, but said governing body shall not fix a rate of levy in any one year on each dollar of assessed tangible valuation for any of the following named purposes in excess of the following named rates:

- Library ..... 4.00 mills
- Airport: Joint operation as provided by  
K.S.A. 3-121 ..... .50 mills
- Highway connecting link: County secondary  
as provided by K.S.A. 68-582 ..... 1.00 mills
- Industrial development: As provided by  
K.S.A. 12-1617h ..... 1.00 mills
- Memorial buildings: As provided by  
K.S.A. 73-407 ..... .50 mills
- Noxious weeds: As provided by  
K.S.A. 2-1318 ..... 1.00 mills
- Deficiency for chemicals and  
materials ..... .50 mills
- Refuse collection: As provided by  
K.S.A. 12-2104 ..... 1.00 mills

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Charter Ordinance No. 5 as originally enacted is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper.

SECTION 4. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the Ordinance, as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision c(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take affect and be in force upon its publication in the official City newspaper.
