CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 32

**A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF DERBY,  
KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. §§25-2303-25-2309, AND  
25-2709, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, PERTAINING TO VOTER  
REGISTRATION RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CITY CLERK.**

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 2079, as enacted by the 1996 legislature, is a nonuniform enactment, and places significant mandates on cities of the first and second class;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1. Exemption.** The City of Derby, Kansas, by virtue of the power vested in it by Article 12, §5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it K.S.A. §§25-2303, 25-2309, and 25-2709, and amendments thereto, which apply to this city but do not apply uniformly to all cities.


**SECTION 2. Publication.** This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Charter ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, §5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
