The Art Gallery at City Hall was established to feature and inspire the artistic talents of Derby residents, especially those of young artists, by contributing to community art appreciation. Rotating exhibits also beautify Derby City Hall for residents, visitors, and staff.

In addition to contributing to the Derby community's appreciation of arts, the Art Gallery aims to inspire artists by providing prominent space for public display of artwork in City Hall.

The Art Gallery at City Hall features artwork from community members, with particular emphasis on art by students in art programs at Derby High School and Middle School. Artists are able to compete for privately sponsored scholarships, when available, and display their artwork in a prestigious community venue. Artists may also sell their artwork to interested parties.

The Art Gallery at City Hall is a partnership between the City of Derby, Derby Schools, and the Derby Recreation Commission.

HOURS

Artwork can be viewed any time City Hall is open to the public, including:

- Business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. (City Hall is closed on holidays).
- City Council meetings on the second and fourth Tuesday of the month at 6:30 p.m.
- Board of Education meetings on the fourth Monday of the month at 6:30 p.m.
